OBJECTIVE:

The Community Farm Facilitator will work with parents, youth, volunteers, partners and staff at “Corazon de la Gente” to cultivate the leadership, maximize the educational potential and transformative value of the community farm.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Work with community leaders (*Equipo de Lideres*) and work with teams to manage various aspects of the farm, including garden maintenance, safety protocols, and healthy communication.
- Administrative support for purchases and donations of materials i.e. garden supplies.
- Facilitate communication between members and conflict resolution processes as needed.
- Work with community leaders to conduct outreach and recruit gardeners each season, as individual garden plots are available.
- Work in collaboration with team member (*promotora de siembra*) to provide direct garden assistance and/or offer workshops to 20 families at the community farm.
- Co-facilitate community farm meetings & support community led decision-making processes.
- Maintain communication with partners including American Friends Service Committee.
- Support backyard gardeners in the neighborhood by providing resources and workshops.
- Work with carpenters and irrigation contractor(s) who perform repair and maintenance activities on farm sites.
- Coordinate volunteers as needed.
